PACOIMA COMMUNITY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Increasing Public Safety

- · Worked with Caltrans to repair and install new fencing to prevent pedestrian access along the 118 FWY.
- Partnered with the LA Department of Building and Safety to resolve issues of nuisance at properties such as 13100 Paxton St.
- Initiated many 3-1-1 reports that resulted in 133 graffiti removals and 362 bulky item/illegal dumping pickups.
- Deployed Operation Bright Spot to frequently visit main corridors such as Van Nuys Blvd., Paxton St., Osborne St., and Foothill Blvd. for weed abatement, powerwashing, and trash removal.
- Partnered with the Altered Shift Response Team is to clean illegal dumping hotspots including:

Building Community

- Hosted Tom LaBonge Day of Service on September 30, and organized a community clean-up surrounding Roger Jessup Park, resulting in multiple large items being disposed of, weed abatement, and trash cleanup along the public right of way.
- Partnered with HACLA to host multiple Section 8 Housing Registration Workshops
- Partnered with the LA Department. of Building and Safety, Neighborhood Legal Services, and the LA Housing Department, to host Housing Rights workshops for both tenants and landlords.
- Sponsored a Tax Day event where community members were able to prepare their taxes for free.

Expanding Opportunities for Youth

- Worked with the LA Department of Transportation to bring Crossing Guards to various schools to enhance pedestrian safety.
- Installed new lighting and CCTV security systems at Ritchie Valens Park and Hubert Humphrey Park.

Delivering Resources to the San Fernando Valley

- Completed critical investment at the intersection of Telfair Ave. and Montague St. with the installation of a traffic circle, 4 new crosswalks, 8 new accessible curb ramps, and partial sidewalk repairs.
- Worked with the Office of Congressman Tony Cardenas to secure \$5 Million in Congressional funding for the construction of a new pedestrian bridge over the Pacoima Wash at Telfair Ave.
- Worked with the Office of Congressman Tony Cardenas to secure \$800,000 in Congressional funding for the creation of a new green space/park along the Pacoima Wash.
- Completed Street Resurfacing on the following streets:
 - Dronfield Av. City limits N/O Corcoran Pl to Corcoran Pl.
 - Remington St., Oneida Av. to Rincon Av.
 - Fellows Ave, Gain St to Terra Bella St

Addressing Homelessness

- In collaboration with LA Family Housing, LAHSA, LA County, Caltrans, and Mayor Bass, we cleared
 encampments at the back part of Paxton Park, the Pacoima Wash, and Caltrans right of way along the
 118 FWY and 5 FWY. It was the largest tent encampment in Pacoima, impacting green space for
 community use. With this coordinated approach, we housed over 50 individuals and have restored the
 recreational use of a community open space.
- Expanded our RV Pilot Program to Pacoima and successfully housed individuals:
 - Near Desmond St and Bradley Ave, resulted in 7 vehicles being safely disposed of and 7 individuals finding housing.
 - Area remains cleared of encampments.
- In our ongoing efforts to enhance community safety and support, we are proud to collaborate with the Crisis and Incident Response Through Community-Led Engagement program, also known as CIRCLE. This innovative initiative, which began in late 2022, offers a unique approach to handling non-urgent 9-1-1 calls involving unhoused individuals. CIRCLE deploys highly trained crisis response teams to address these situations promptly and effectively. Additionally, the program proactively conducts outreach in areas with high concentrations of unhoused individuals, stepping in before the need for a 9-1-1 call arises. CIRCLE is currently active in Pacoima, Mission Hills, and North Hills, further reinforcing our commitment to community well-being and safety.
